

6 – Comments:

Although there is no national legislation in Spain regarding safety in the Outdoors, a programme safety measure has recently been set up at national level as a National Standard.

In Spain, the level of safety input in the outdoors is rather global and sectoral and does cover the 5 components of management, staff, customers, environment and equipment. The enforcement however remains within the goodwill of the professionals. Moreover, the economic crisis has forced the Spanish employers organisation ANETA to go dormant. The latter will certainly delay the set-up of a Spanish co-regulatory programme safety scheme for the outdoor sector.

Although only one measure has been found in Spain, it's capacity to cover the various aspects that should be covered by a safety measure, gives Spain a high potential to implement safety within outdoor leisure activities.

The overall effectiveness of measures related to safety of outdoor leisure activities in Spain corresponds to pattern N°2.
