

#### **6 – Comments:**

Belgium does have a national legislation on 'active leisure', making it compulsory for outdoor providers to elaborate a 'programme safety scheme'. SME's have either established such a programme by themselves or through their national employers union (BFNO). However, the combination of national legislation and programme safety creates a very high constraint on Belgian SME's.

As a consequence, the national employers' union (BFNO) has developed a national programme safety scheme that covers all aspects of investigation. The consequence of this model is a "global-local" approach involving employers in safety management. Belgium is one of the 3 countries matching pattern N°1 (BE, FI, GB) in terms of effectiveness. Belgium leaves a great deal of definition space to the SME's.

The Belgium approach is clearly a global, "holistic" sectoral approach taking into account every components and aspects of safety in outdoor leisure activities. Non- regulatory measures even deal with such issues as environment evaluation and equipment (in other countries left to ISO and CEN standards).

The overall effectiveness of measures related to safety of outdoor leisure activities in Belgium corresponds to pattern N°1.
