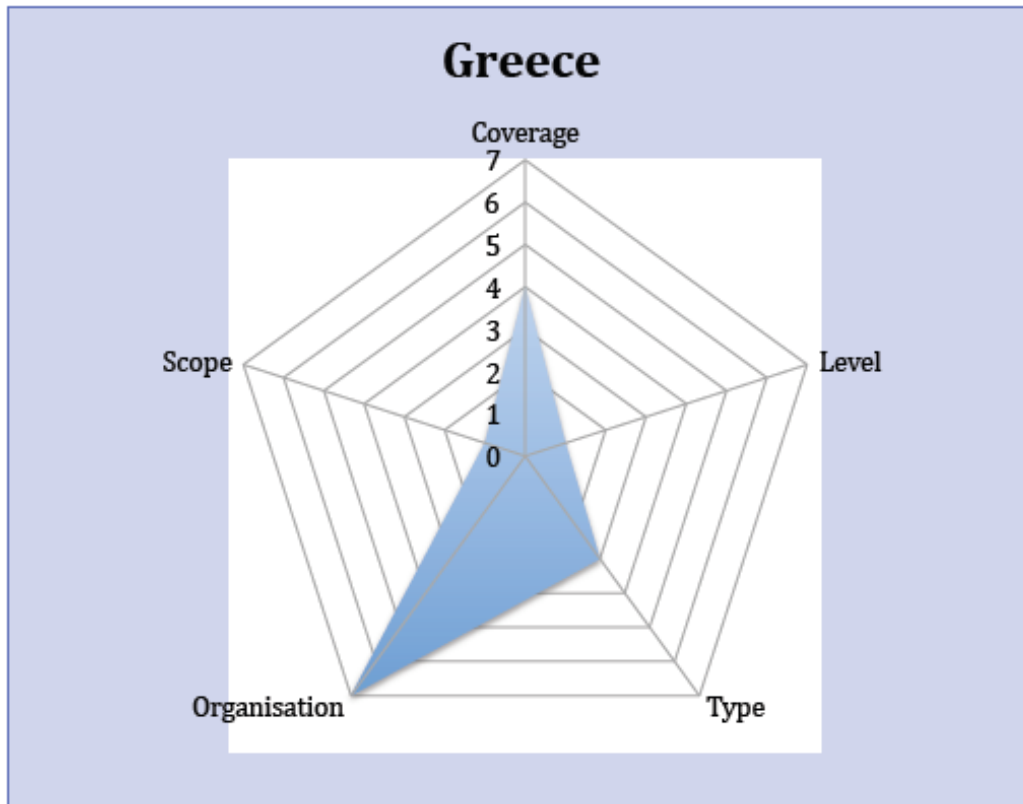

6 – Comments:

Greece does not have a national law that governs the Outdoors in terms of safety. No national or regional, sector or activity based programme safety measures have been found either.

The Greek approach is therefore based on non-regulatory measures such as codes of conduct that might be taken for each activity and / or on a local base.

Safety issues in the Outdoors seem to be left very much down to the companies involved as far as management, staff training and customer information is concerned, and down to the European and World conventions and standards as far as management of the environment and equipment safety are concerned.

Greece has a very low potential for implementing an overall programme safety policy.

The overall effectiveness of measures related to safety of outdoor leisure activities in Greece corresponds to pattern N°4.
